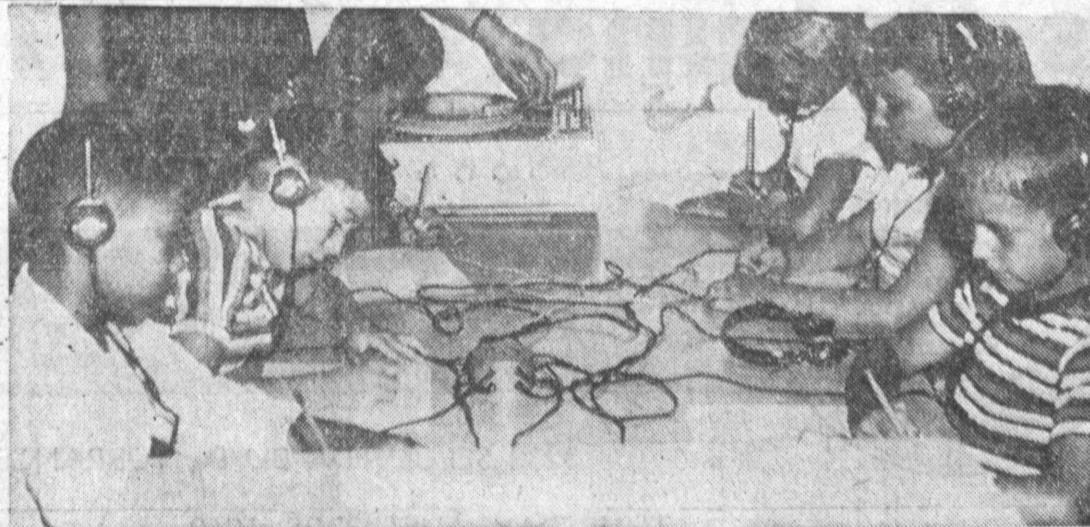

(Continued from Page One) Minnesota, in pre-school sessions. Schools will be in session for 176 days, ending June 15, 1961. Schools will be closed on Veteran's Day, Nov. 11; Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 24 and 25; Christmas, Dec. 19-Jan. 2; Lincoln's Birthday, Feb. 13; Washington's Birthday, Feb. 22; Easter, March 27-31; and Memorial Day, May 30. Five elementary schools will have new principals—Phillip Korman, Anza; Roy Adamson, Riviera; John McGee, Madison; John Kasser, Steele; and Richard Gosh-

ong, Towers. In addition to the new Towers and Madison School openings, the district will also move into four new classrooms and a music room at Carr Elementary School. Classroom additions currently are under construction at Flavian, Magruder, and Crenshaw Schools and should be ready for use by early next year. Additions to South High School currently are under way, but this work probably will not be ready during this school year. Site work has begun on West High School, which is slated open in September, 1962.
