Adventist Gives Lecture on Politics v.s. Pulpit

Ministers, Bible instructors and all other Southern California workers of the Seventh-day Adventist church were counseled recently by Southland headquarters of the denomination to keep politics out of the pulpit.
 Warren L. Johns, Glendale, Southland Adventist director of religious liberty, has told church workers, "As a church we do not plan to enter into the current political campaign."
 "To become embroiled in any issue other than preaching Christ would tend to neutralize the church's effectiveness," John said. "The church must keep before its members the sole reason for its existence—to win men to Christ."
 "If individual members desire to participate in any of the activities of an election it is privilege and right to do so as citizens, taking care not to involve the church," he said.
 "To preach from the pulpit in favor of a candidate could so arouse the feelings of the candidate's opponents that it might be impossible to ever speak to them in later years about the saving grace of Christ," Johns declared.
 While giving this counsel against church involvement in politics, Johns said, "it should not be thought that individuals in the church should in any way forgo their right and duty to vote for candidates and issues of their choice."
 "The individual vote, cast for the individual that represents the principles—a person—believes in, is an important part of the Christian witness," the official said.

State Reports Huge Surplus

California's budgeted state expenditures have cost about 10 million dollars less than estimated earlier this year, State Finance Director John Carr reported this week.
 The savings came from a combination of factors, he explained. Some involve direct economies of operation, while others stem from lesser workloads or smaller student and institutional populations than had been anticipated in some places.
 The savings helped swell the 1959-60 surplus reported last week by State Controller Alan Cranston to \$129,252,173, or about 30 million dollars in excess of earlier estimates.
 In addition to the 10 million dollar item, another 20 million dollars was accounted for as "carryover" of flood control and capital outlay expenditures which were postponed into the current fiscal year.
