Dairy Sponsors Essay Contest

Sponsoring a campaign to increase interest in national events and participation in the November election, the Mayfair Creamery in Torrance is holding an essay contest on the Constitution.

Prizes for winning essays, which will be printed on Mayfair milk cartons, are \$25 U.S. Savings Bonds and a trip to Washington D.C., grand prize.

The contest, commencing Sept. 1, with a different essay chosen weekly, is open to grade and high school students.

Weekly Contests

The weekly essays will cover specific sections of the Constitution. Winners of these contests will be eligible to enter the grand contest, commenting on the entire Constitution.

Judging entries will be members of the history department staff of El Camino College. Entry blanks may be obtained at local food and beverage stores, John Melville, manager of the creamery, said.

Melville, who originated the contest, stated he became interested in promoting the American way of life during his college days.

National Interest

Then, majoring in political science, as he was a member of Pi Sigma Alpha, honorary political science fraternity, he became interested in the historical and political background of the United States.

"The coming November election will be one of the most important in the history of our Nation," he declared. "The interest we take at the polls may profoundly influence the attitude of the rest of the world toward us."

"To this extent, I feel every person should take a long and serious look at the fundamental principles upon which this country was built," stated Melville, in explaining the purpose of the competition.

Uncertain World

"Today's youth will have to face a tough and uncertain world. I am convinced, however, that a realistic understanding of our basic principles contained in the Constitution will add strength in solving tomorrow's problems," he added.


