Homemade Relish Flavors Hot Dogs

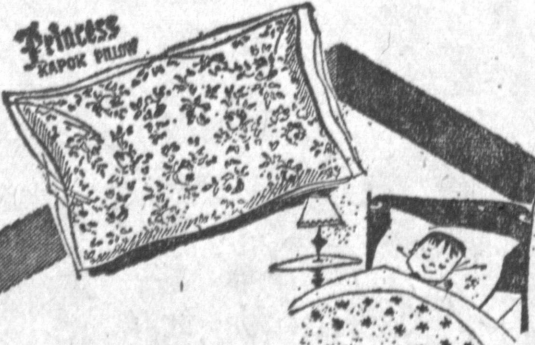
Homemade relishes designed to add taste to that family hot dog or hamburger barbecue, can be made in just a jiffy.

 3 tablespoons diced green pepper
 2 tablespoons chopped pimiento
 1/3 cup French dressing
 1 tablespoon vinegar
 Combine all ingredients in a bowl; toss to mixwell. Put mixture into pint-size, screw-top jar. Store in refrigerator 2 or 3 days before using. Makes about 1 pint.

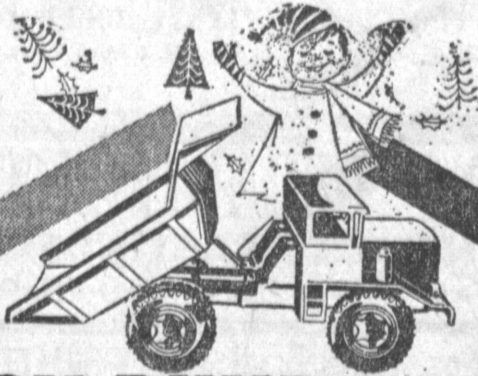

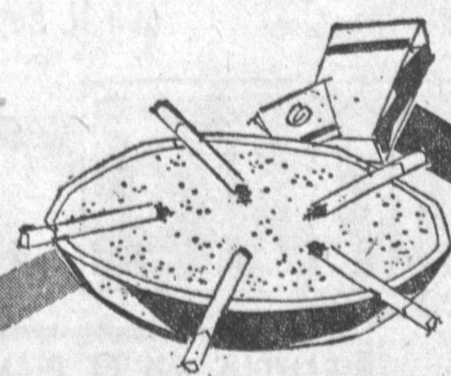
