Saxons Take 2nd Victory

Stunned early in the first quarter by a North High fumble that cost the Saxons a touchdown, Shoup's chargers, nevertheless recovered and went on to trounce an Inglewood High eleven 19-6 before a crowd estimated at 3400 at North High Stadium Friday night.

Passing and running North High's quarterback, Carey Hubert, led the Saxons to a touchdown before the first quarter ended to tie at 6-6 Hubert on a roll-out, carried over from the three yard line. The attempt for the extra point failed when Hubert was stopped short of the goal line on an end run.

Ray Dohner, Rick Jacobs and Hubert got together midway in the second quarter to forge ahead of the Sentinels, the latter going down to defeat by the same score handed out to them by the Tartars a week ago. A sensational pass from Hubert, that carried for 50 yards, to Pat Lininger added another six points to North's total and when the half ended the Torrance eleven led by a 12-6 margin.

Troy Winslow was stopped by the Saxons who charged the sensational quarterback each time in crucial situations.

In the fourth quarter Gary Wright of the Saxons intercepted a Winslow pass and ran it to the Inglewood 22. Hubert then flipped to Felix Alvillar to the 18, another toss to Lininger in the end zone and North scored its third touchdown of the night. Jeff Bell then handed to Dohner who went over for the extra point.
