

"Recent research has shown that these factors appear in nonreading children. even those with average or gifted intelligence, at least four times as often as children able to read through usual teaching methods," he declared.

"Only a complete medical examination, including perceptual testing, can provide an accurate diagnosis. However, if every kindergarten child were routinely examined, necessary remedial steps could be taken immediately averting learning failures, at tendant anxieties and behavior problems," Dr. Zike stated. Special psychological and educational techniques will be explained at the meeting by Ivy Mooring, Ph.D., director of research and guidance, Palos Verdes School District; and Marianne Frostig, Ph.D., director, Marianne Frostig School for Education 'Therapy, 7257 Melrose, Los Angeles.
