

Stock Cars Go at Saugus

Highlighting this Saturday night's stock car racing program at Saugus Stadium is a 50-lap Fall Championship race which could well be the deciding factor in the 1960 Pacific Racing Association championship.

The important event will see 100 points awarded to the winning driver, and only 84 points are presently separating first and third positions in the championship standings. Current point leaders Ben Thomas, Canoga Park has 1064; Hal Grist, Van Nuys, 1006; and Giff Runkle, Moorpark, 980 head the list of more than eighty stock car speedsters in P.R.A. standings.

New Tamale Pie for Busy Gals

While the Tamale Pie is baking, toss together a crisp green salad. It adds both the proper color and flavor note.

Tamale Pie
(Makes 4 to 6 servings)

Corn Meal Crust
2½ cups water
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon chili powder
1¼ cups Albers Yellow Corn Meal

Tamale Pie Filling
1 tablespoon shortening
1 pound ground beef
½ cup chopped onion
½ cup sliced ripe olives
2 cups stewed tomatoes
½ cup whole kernel corn
½ teaspoon salt
½ to 1 teaspoon garlic salt

1 tablespoon chili powder
1 cup grated cheddar cheese

Combine cold water, salt, chili powder and corn meal in a sauce-pan over medium heat. Cook until thickened (about 15 minutes) stirring frequently. When thickened, line the sides of a 1½ quart casserole with about 2/3 of corn meal mixture.

While corn meal mixture is cooking, melt shortening in frying pan. Brown meat and onion. Add remaining ingredients except ½ cup of cheese. Simmer about 20 minutes. Pour into corn meal-lined casserole. Spoon remaining corn meal mixture around edges of casserole. Top with reserved ½ cup grated cheese. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 45 minutes.
