I put my bread to rise next to Aunt Gussie's and punched it down when she punched hers. And I set my two precious loaves to bake in the same oven, and at the same temperature. And my bread was just the same as hers.

Gas Co. Seeks Total Employee Aid for AID

One hundred percent employee enrollment in the current AID-United Givers program is this year's goal set by the Southern California Gas Co.'s Southwest Division, according to division manager George Babbe.
