The Saxons didn't win, they were tied by the Spartans last Friday night at North High Stadium.

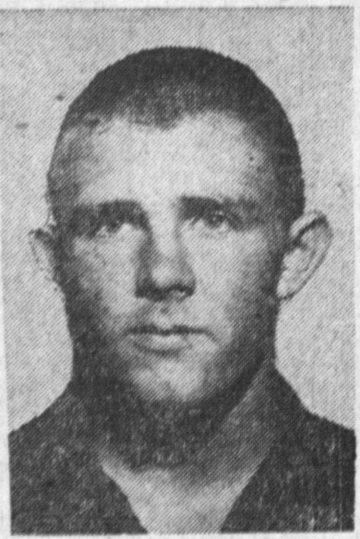


AUSTIN

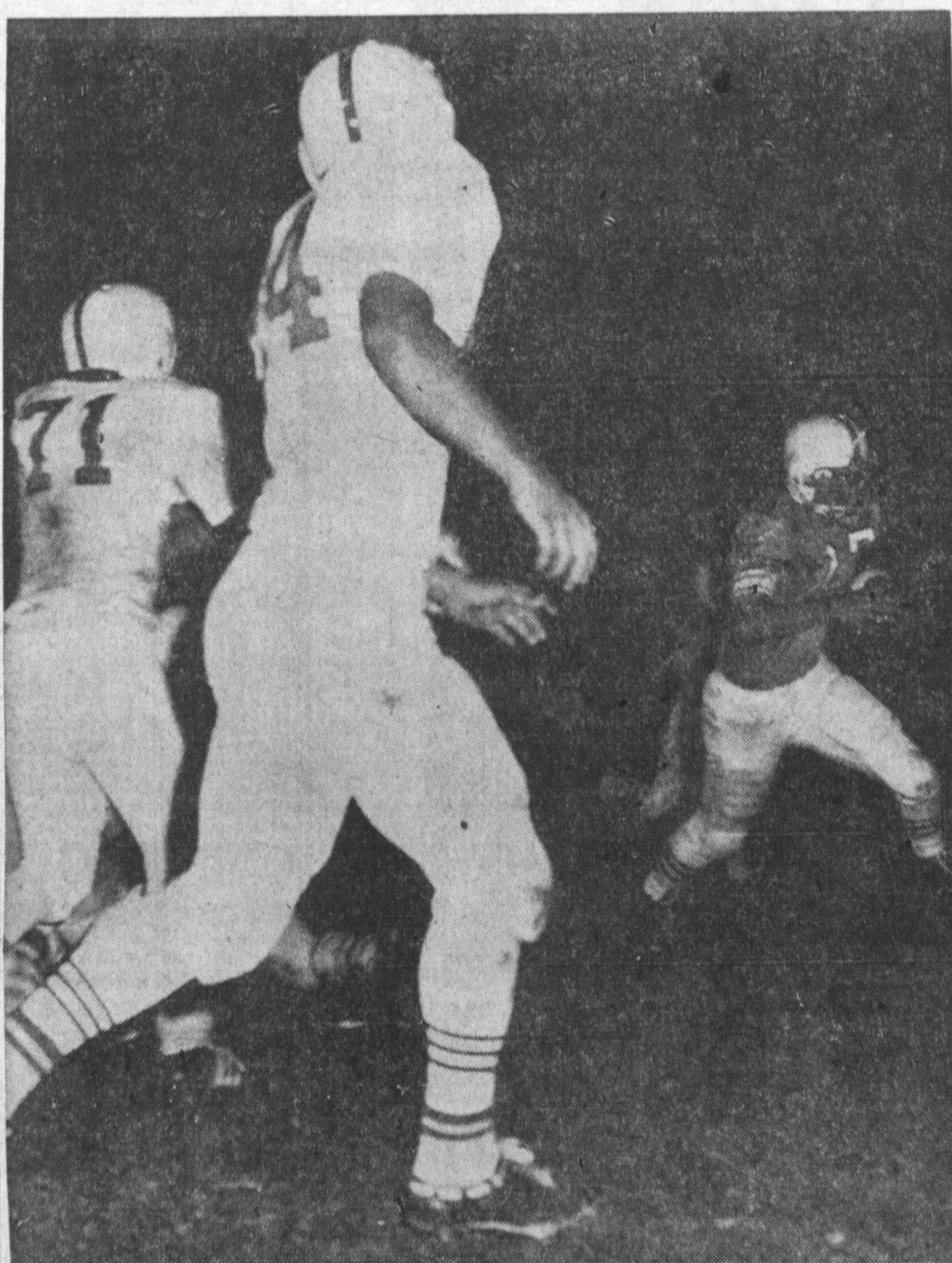
The South Gate "Stars" led by Ronnie Barnes, defeated the Torrance Chargers in the midget division 13-0.
