C-of-C Officer Urges Passage of Water Bond

An inadequate supply in Southern California may be the result of failure to approve the Water Bond Act, Proposition 1, on the November ballot, warned area representatives yesterday.

James S. Cantlen, president of the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce said, "Water is a resource that we simply have to have or the dynamic progress of the Southland will grind to a halt." He urged a favorable vote on the \$1,750,000,000 measure.

He pointed out that underground basins were already badly overdrawn and although Colorado River water should take care of surface needs for the next 10 to 12 years, indications are there will be diminishing supplies available for protecting these basins against depletion and salt water intrusion.

"While Proposition 1 is not a perfect piece of legislation," Cantlen added, "It is better than might be expected where so many conflicting interests throughout the State are involved, and preferable to any alternative that appears attainable."

Cantlen said both the Metropolitan Water District and the City Department of Water and Power support the fact that additional water will be needed by 1970 or 1975.

Pheasant Tags Available Now

Pheasant tags for the 1960 season opening Nov. 12 statewide are now available from any of the approximately 1,200 hunting license agents throughout Southern California and the Inyo-Mono area, reports the Department of Fish and Game.

The tags sell 10 for \$2 and one of them must be punched and attached immediately to a leg of each pheasant taken. This year's pheasant tags must be attached to the pheasant's leg by using a string, cord, or piece of wire, and it will be up to the hunter to

provide his own string or wire. The DFG suggests that pheasant hunters buy their tags now from their local hunting license agent, pointing out that some license agents in the outlying areas may run out of tags on opening weekend.

Supervisor Predicts Senate Bill Adoption November 8

A prediction that Proposition 15 will be adopted at the November 8 election was made early this week by Supervisor Frank G. Bonelli at a luncheon for Los Angeles newspaper editors at the Biltmore Hotel.

"The polls show that voters are fair and that they favor Senate Reapportionment," Bonelli said. "This is true throughout the state."

The supervisor reiterated declarations that several large public utilities firms and financial institutions are fighting the measure "because they want to retain the present dynasty they have in the Senate."

He pointed out that 15 senators representing one million people living in thinly populated countries along the Oregon and Nevada borders, are the dominant influence in the Senate.

Proposition 15 would redistrict the state to give the densely populated coastal countries additional representation Bonelli said.

"It is common knowledge the high corporations fighting Proposition 15 believe they receive better treatment from the present Senate than they would under a Senate responsible to the people," he stated.

The supervisor said there is no chance the Senate would reapportion itself voluntarily.
