**Women Near Quota for Community Chest Appeal**

Some 20 local business leaders are working with Dr. Robert Jackson in the Advance Gifts division of the appeal. Advance Gifts division is soliciting those area merchants who are in a position to make generous gifts to the United Way appeal.

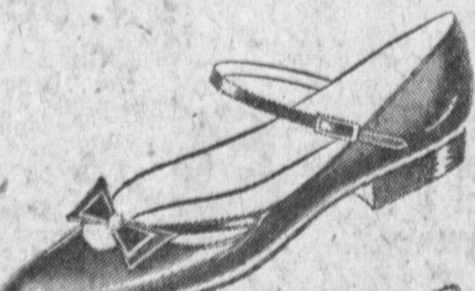
