

DA 5-1515. School, Torrance, can answer these questions and many others as the result of term papers they have written. Their research papers are complete with bibliographies, lists of the resource books they used.

Although term papers formerly were a skill reserved for college students, Torrance High school students and upper grade classes are doing work with the "work-study skills, including research, note-taking, extensive study of sources of information, and making reports, both written and oral.

LEARNING TECHNIQUES "Years ago, it was possible for students to learn or memorize nearly all the knowledge that was known," Mrs. Hause noted. "Today, knowledge has expanded to the point where no one can know everything there is to know. However, we try to teach our students to learn where they can find needed information-in encyclopedias, almanacs, resource books, magazines, and other types of material."

Mrs. Hause set up the term paper project, allowing the students to pick some current topic that interested them. Since this was an election year many students picked topics dealing with the election—biographies of one of the candidates, a study of the party symbols, the electoral college, and of the systems of elections.
