Nobel Prize to Cal Scientists For Lab Studies

The 1960 Nobel Prizes in both chemistry and physics have been awarded to University of California scientists.
The \$43,625 prizes went to
Willard F. Libby, professor
of chemistry at UCLA, and Donald A. Glaser, professor of physics on the University's Berkeley campus.

Glaser received the prize in physics for his invention and development of the bubble chamber, a device which in its various forms is used in high-energy physics labora-tories throughout the world to collect hundreds of times more data on the nature of nuclear particles and their interactions that was previously possible.

The prize in chemistry went to Libby for his development of and research with the radioactive carbon "time clock," a technique by which the age of fossils 50,000 years old can be dated within 200






