Supervisors Block Attempts to Hike Summer Swimming Pool Fees

An attempt to increase admission fees for the use of County owned and operated swimming pools at parks and playgrounds was blocked this week by the Board of Supervisors, following the leadership of Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

The recommended increases, which might curtail summer sports activities, was submitted by the County Parks and Recreation Commission to bring about "a greater degree of standardization of fees charged by public and private organizations throughout Los Angeles County," were blocked by unanimous vote of the supervisors.

COUNTY LIFE-GUARDS

Supervisor Hahn pointed out that the County provides life-guard services and other necessary facilities at the County operated beaches at no cost to the public.

"In addition, the County each year allocates \$75,000 each to the cities of Los Angeles, Long Beach and Santa Monica to assist in providing life-guard services at beaches operated by the cities," he said.

Supervisor Hahn stated that not everyone can go to the beaches and enjoy the free swimming there—and that any increase in swimming pool fees would discourage children living in congested areas from using County swimming pools.

DOESN'T MAKE SENSE

"It really doesn't make any sense to charge for the use of swimming pools and provide free swimming at the beaches," he continued, adding that he was in favor of abolishing all fees at County swimming pools.

He added that he believes that the admission fees now charged do not meet the cost of collecting the fees when all costs are included—printing of tickets, salaries of ticket takers, and hidden administrative costs.

"I believe that it would be much better for all of the fees to be abolished and thus encourage greater use of our swimming pools—which are the most used attractions in our parks in the summer months."

Poison Time Bomb

Your three-year-old may be eating something now which can make him seriously sick next summer. That "something" is lead. Children under five often take in a good deal of lead, with no symptoms that mother notices for months. For some reason which nobody clearly understands yet, the youngsters develop obvious symptoms mostly after they have been exposed to hot sunlight.

Most modern indoor paint contains very little lead. But if your house is 20 years old or so, there may be many underlayers of lead-containing paint on woodwork, walls and ceiling. Many children eat crumbling pieces of plaster and flakes of peeling paint, and chew the paint off window sills.

Though you can buy indoor paint with little or no lead in it, outdoor paint is still lead-loaded. So don't ever be tempted to use exterior paint for an interior job. Repair crumbling plaster, scrape and repaint flaking surfaces. And try to stop baby from chewing on the woodwork. It is not harmless, as many parents seem to think.

If lead poisoning is discovered too late, it can mean death or permanent damage to the brain and nervous system. Watch for such symptoms as lack of appetite, abdominal cramps, vomiting, pallor, irritability, drowsiness, lack of coordination. Take the baby to a doctor immediately if any of these signs appear. Lead poisoning can be cured only if it is discovered early and treated by an expert.

HIGHEST INCIDENCE
