More than likely, however, he will do as countless others have, start by consulting a local member of the California Association of Nurseymen, who in the most cases have land-scape departments.

With the nurseryman's help, a good plan can be put on paper, and his suggestions for plant material will simplify the task no end. He will suggest which elements of the plan need immediate attention and which others can wait their turn—to be completed.

Before seeking help, measure the dimentions of the lot and put them in their proper proportion on a piece of paper. Then, locate existing structures on this plot—house, garage or shed. Rough in existing walks and the driveway, and—if there is an already established garden—show all planted areas, too. Thus armed, drop in on the C.A.N. Nurseryman and start filling in the blank spaces.

Handy Deck

Many a home owner has had an extra wood deck installed outside his master bedroom to give him a private lounging spot away from the family. Decks built of Douglas fir, spaced for easy water runoff, also can be protected with a solid railing of fir boards for privacy.
