Woman to Tell Horrors of Atom Bomb at Services

One August Day in 1945. 15-year-old Yoshiko Taguchi was at her desk in a mission school in Hiroshima, Japan, when a white luminous flash attracted her attention and a fraction of a second later she felt herself spinning through the air like a projectile for 50 feet toward the end of the

The walls of the building collapsed, burying her in a pile of broken glass, plaster, wood and twisted steel. Blood poured from her mouth and from 159 wounds on her body and she received what doctors later said was a deadly dose of radiation. Yoshiko is the only one of more than 300 persons from her village, working in Hiroshima, who survived the atom blast.

"I pray every day that no one else will ever have to know this suffering," said Yoshiko. "I am so thankful to be alive. No one but God has saved me. I feel I must do something to thank God for saving my life. I will dedicate my life to Him and to humanity. I want to build bridges, bridges of peace and friend-
