Harbor City Park - Play ground's site is being acguired under provisions of the recereation and park bond fund and a bond-fund allocation will finance the facility's development.

Parcel 8 is an improved lot 50 feet wide and 118 feet deep on Lomita Boulevard, west of Frampton Avenue, and will be acquired at a cost of \$10,050. Parcel 9 is also improved, is 100 feet wide and 118 feet deep and will be acquired at a cost of \$23,325.

Negotiations are underway for several parcels needed for the park-palyground's site and others are in escrow, according to the Recreation and Park Department.
