New Roster Lists Realtors

One hundred and twenty-two realtors and 281 associates from Torrance and Lomita, members of the Torrance Lomita Board, are listed in the huge 304-page roster issue of the California Real Estate Magazine, now in the mail to all of the 34,000 members of the California Real Estate Association, it was announced by Delbert Vaughn, president of the board. This represents a healthy growth in the membership for the board, Vaughn said.

The growth in membership of the statewide association in the last year was more than 1,500 realtors and real estate salesmen, according to Kenneth H. Smitten of San Francisco, association president. He said that more than 14,000 of the members of the

association are realtors—real estate brokers recognized as qualified professionals through their membership in the National Association of Real Estate Boards. Realtors are pledged to a code of ethics which assures the public of better service, fairness and honesty in their real estate transactions. The associate members are employed by realtors.

GROWTH

"This healthy growth in realtor membership reflects the growing recognition by buyers and sellers of real estate of the professional assistance provided by realtors," Smitten said.

Because of the reference value of this special issue, more than 2,000 additional copies are mailed to major libraries, consuls, chambers of commerce, large corporations, and others interested in California real estate throughout the country, said Smitten. For the first time since this publication was originated in 1920, a four-color picture of a California scene appears on the cover of the issue.

The magazine contains many articles with numerous illustrations and charts telling the story of the dynamic growth of California.

The combination of statistics and information in this issue are not found in any other single publication. One section contains a complete statistical record of each of the 58 counties in California, rainfall, population, chief crop and industries, minerals, number of motor vehicles, deeds recorded, assessed valuation, bonded debt, tax rate, and other information pertinent to the schools, industries, railroads and other

FEATURE

A new feature introduced this year is a map section that graphically illustrates the many advantages of business and agriculture in California. Other maps show all of the recreational resources in the state including the state and national parks.

One article tells of California

economy's dynamic growth from 1950 to 1960. Some of the statistics revealed in this article are astounding, as a 10-year increase of the state population from 10,586,223 in 1950 to 15,717,204 in 1960—a 48.7 per cent increase. The area in the state experiencing the largest percentage growth was San Jose, Santa Clara County, with 121.34 per cent increase in pop-

ulation. Per capita personal income rose from 1,848 in 1950 to \$2,753 in 1960—over 100 per cent. Retail sales went from \$13 billion in 1950 to 22 billion in 1960. Growth in employment in the Los Angeles-Long Beach standard metropolitan statistical area made the area second to New York in numbers employed.

Harbor Offers Summer Program

Transistors, television fundamentals, and radio code will head the list of technical courses offered at Harbor College during summer session, announced Dr. Robert V. Bacon, Dean of Summer Session.

Operation and testing of transistors as well as their application to computers and compact devices of the space age will be presented in both lecture and laboratory phases of Electronics 22, Transistors.

The testing and troubleshooting of home television circuits will be emphasized in Electronics 21, Television Fundamentals, through the use of the oscilloscope and other laboratory equipment.

LICENSING

Radio code and the electronic theory necessary to pass licensing examinations for amateur and commercial radio operation will be presented in Electronics 14, Communication Electronics.

George Rainey, electronics instructor for more than a decade, will teach the courses which are scheduled for the evening hours between 6 and 10 p.m.

TECHNICAL COURSES

Other technical courses offered during the six-week summer sessions are automation science, petroleum testing, printing typography, machine typesetting, Linotype-intertype, and cylinder press-work operation.

Registration for the summer session will be held on Thursday and Friday, July 6 and 7, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Classes start on July 10, and will end August 18. No admission tests or transcripts are required.
