Catalina's pace continues even after sundown, with boat trips around the harbor to watch the exciting flying fish in action, and dining and dancing nightly at Avalon's

fabled Casino, to the music of Moestro Russ Morgan and his band.

### BIG NEWS

Inaugurated early this summer, Catalina's "Parade of Big Names," has been packing the Casino Ballroom Friday and Saturday nights. Songstress Gogi Grant opened the season, followed by Roberta Sherwood, the Mary Kaye Trio and Tony Martin. Frankie Lane is due the weekend of July 14-15. Accommodations abound on Catalina Island, with cottages and hotels dotting the arc of hills around Avalon Town.

While boats of all sizes from tiny outboards to luxury yachts bring visitors to the island, main transportation is furnished by the S.S. Catalina. In addition to her daily sailings each morning at 9:45, the Big White Ship has her Moonlight Cruises at 7:30 p.m. each Friday and Saturday night. On Sunday, to make certain that everyone who wants to go to the island gets there, the Catalina sails at 9:45 a.m. and again at 4 p.m.
