

ten years of age accounted for 50 per cent of all paralytic polio cases in Los Angeles County, it was pointed out. Three properly spaced shots are needed for complete protection, with annual boster shots recommended.

March of Dimes officials declared that with the stepped-up inoculation program now underway, intervals between\_inoculations should be two weeks between the first two injections, with the third administered four weeks later.

They pointed out that the new oral Sabin vaccine will not be generally available in time to combat polio during the approaching polio season, but that there is no shortage of the effective Salk vaccine, developed through March of Dimes funds.
