PREVAILING WAGE RATES

The Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County Flood Control District has ascertained the prevailing rate of per diem wages in dollars, hased on a working day of eight hours, for each eraft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute any construction contract which may be awarded by the Los Angeles County Flood Control District to be as follows and as detailed below.

Except as otherwise apecifically provided for painter classifications, the rates of per diem wages for each of the various classifications of work shall be the hereinfetr est forth prevailing rates of hourly wages plus the hourly equivalent of any employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation and similar purposes multiplied by eight. Eight hours shall constitute a day's work; it being understood that in the event that workmen are employed less than eight hours. The per diem wages have that workmen are employed less than eight hours and had lived in Los Angeles most of his life. Sec. 1775. FORFEITURE FOR PAYING LESS THAN PREVAILING RATE:

STIPULATION.

The contractor shall forfeit ten dollars for each calendar day, or portion thereof, for each workman paid less than the stipulated prevailing rates for any public work done under the contract by him or by any subcontractor under him.

Provided that overtime rates, rate of pay for Saturdays, Sundays and holidays shall apply to those holidays as recognized in the collective bargaining agreement applicable to the particular craft, classification or type of workman empoyed on the project.

Provided that notwithstanding the general provisions contained herein, Guards

Provided that notwithstanding the general provisions contained herein, Guards and Watchmen shall be paid one and one-half times the prevailing rate for overline (overtime-shall be time worked in excess of eight hours per day or forthours per week), and the straight prevailing rate for time worked on Saturdays.
