Specialist Crocker, a cook in the company, entered the Army in 1954, was last stationed at Fort Ord and arrived overseas on this tour of duty in December 1959.

Crocker is a 1950 graduate of Narbonne High School, Lomita. His wife, Barbara, is with him in Germany.

Pfc Donald L. Galloway, 20, son of Wallace H. Galloway, Lomita, recently participated with other personnel from the 8th Division's 504th Infantry in annual Army training tests near Wiesbaden, Germany.

The three-day tests, which were designed to determine individual and unit efficiency under simulated combat conditions, included both day and night maneuvers and stressed the role of Galloway's unit in both the attack and in defense. At the conclusion of the tests, members of the 504th were airlifted by helicopter to Mainz where they are regularly stationed.

A medical aidman in the infantry's Headquarters Company, Galloway entered the Army in June 1959 and arrived overseas last April. He is a 1959 graduate of South Gate High School.

Army Private Richard A. Rogers, 18, son of Mr. and Mrs. T. E. Rogers, 2102 W. 160th, Torrance, completed the eight-week field communications crewman course July 14 at Fort Ord.

Rogers was trained in communications wire laying, message center organization, and switchboard operation. A 1960 graduate of North High School, he entered the Army last March.

Doctors Advise About Use of Wonder Drug

One of the oldest of the wonder drugs is plain old ordinary aspirin. Although nobody yet understands quite how it works, aspirin is an effective pain reliever. Patients with arthritis take it for long periods of time with considerable relief and no ill effects.

There's some reason to doubt that the fancy types of aspirin, sold for a lot more than the ordinary kind, are really any better, so if you need aspirin there's no need to pinch your pocketbook.

However, when it comes to self-medication, there are always some precautions to observe:

While it's quite safe to take a couple of aspirins for an occasional headache or minor ache, if you find yourself taking aspirins several times a day for several days, go and see your doctor. You may have some illness that needs his attention.

Don't use aspirin to reduce a fever unless your doctor tells you to. A raised temperature is a sign of something wrong and it's never wise to cover up a symptom which can help your doctor to diagnose your ailment.

If aspirin gives you a burning feeling in your stomach, take it with a full glass of water to which you've added a pinch of bicarbonate of soda.

Don't give adult type aspirin (5 grains) to children. There are special weaker strength aspirin tablets for the youngsters. And keep all aspirin out of the children's reach. In large quantities aspirin is poisonous.
