

Eight Dory Teams to Race During Paddleboard Fete

Eight two-man dory teams will race in the Aug. 19 dory race from the Isthmus of Catalina Island to Manhattan Beach Pier, according to L. A. "Bob" Jean, director of the Sixth International Paddleboard Festival.

The Festival, the biggest part of which is the paddleboard race across the same 32-mile channel course the following day, is sponsored by the County of Los Angeles, the City of Manhattan Beach and the International Paddleboard Festival Association, Inc.

Dory crews and dories will be transported to the Isthmus

of Catalina Island the day before the race, and will leave at dawn Saturday. Winners are expected to finish sometime between 11 and 12 a.m.

iel Brown, Palos Verdes Estates, and Karl Adamson, San Pedro; and Gary Clarke, Long Beach, and John Hiatt. Two other teams are expected to enter within the week, according to John James, dory race chairman for the Paddleboard Festival.

Winning time of 5 hours 27 minutes was turned in last year by Tom Volk and Charles Reimers, with Richard Knight and Darrell Wiley placing second in 6 hours and 7 minutes. Third place was captured by Herbert Barthels and Chad Long, a mere 15 minutes behind the second place team.

Friday, September 1, 6:30 to 9 p.m. Arcadia County Park Pool, 405 S. Santa Anita Avenue, Arcadia.

Friday, September 15, 7 to 9 p.m., Certified Divers, 4420 E. Holt Avenue, Montclair.

All persons who pass the rigid requirements in Self Contained Underwater Breathing Apparatus (SCUBA) will be issued official ability certificates by the underwater aquatics section of the County Department of Parks and Recreation.

Persons with previous skin diving experience are urged to submit to these tests for their own self reassurance and in the general interests of safety.

Applicants should bring the following: mask, fins, snorkel, full wet suit, weight belt, tank and regulator, towel, pencil, and swim suit.
