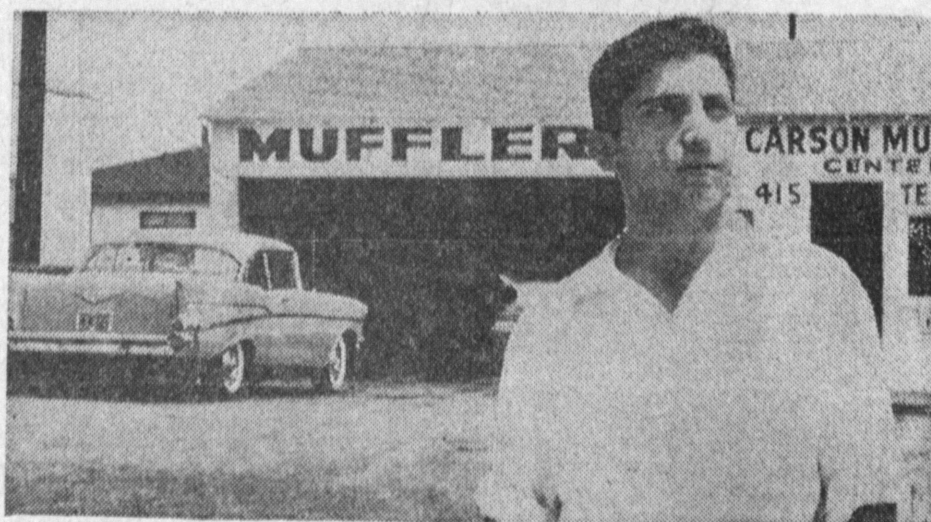
## Canoeing Class At Benshead Pool
