AT HOLLYWOOD BOWL...

Star-Filled Bills Coming to Bowl

Judy Garland, Julie London, the Limelites and Henry Mancini's Orchestra are scheduled to appear in September at the Hollywood Bowl.

Miss Garland will make her first appearance in Los Angeles in several years when she appears Saturday, September 16. The well-known songstress, remembered since she made the Wizard of Oz famous, has a facility that often enables her to exercise mass hypnotism on her audience.

Beauty, brains and music will be combined Saturday, September 23, when Stereo-At-The-Bowl, featuring Miss London, the Limelites and Mancini, is on the program. Miss London is known for

her sultry recordings, including "Cry Me a River." Mancini's instrumentals, notably themes from "Peter Gunn" and "Mr. Lucky," have made him famous. The Limelites are among the top trios in the nation.

Lou Gottlieb of the Limelites holds a Ph.D. in musicology from Berkeley and Mancini is an alumnus of Juilliard Institute and Carnegie Tech.

John Hewitt Enters Air Academy

Cadet John A. Hewitt, Jr., son of Col. and Mrs. J. A. Hewitt, of 181 Via Monte Doro, Redondo Beach, has successfully completed seven weeks of basic cadet training at the United States Air Force Academy near Colorado Springs, Colo.

The Class of 1965, of which he is a member, was formally accepted into the cadet wing at a parade and ceremony Aug. 17. They began their formal academic training along with the rest of the 2,200-man cadet wing when the Academy started its school year on Aug. 21.

The acceptance ceremony marked the end of the training period which began for the 800-man class on June 26, when they arrived at the Academy to begin a four-year course of study leading to regular Air Force commissions as second lieutenants and bachelor of science degrees.

Under the leadership of Academy upperclassmen, the new cadets received a total of 463 hours of summer training. In its broadest aspects the training covered the fields of basic military training; physical conditioning; the growth and development of the Air Force; physiological indoctrination, which acquaints the basic cadet with such matters as problems of high altitude flight and bodily reactions to conditions encountered; and an introduction to flying training, including orientation flights in operational aircraft.

Climaxing basic cadet training was a one-week land survival program in which the cadets received instruction in survival techniques and applied what they learned in a 22-mile trek through the wilderness.
