

Trade College Offers Classes In English, Political Science

The opening of four new classes, the completed construction of a new basic physics laboratory containing \$12,000 worth of equipment, and the consideration of two new curriculums was announced this week by administrators of Los Angeles Trade-Technical College, one of the seven Los Angeles public junior colleges.

The four new classes to be added to the college's Fall schedule of courses for the Academic Department are in the areas of English, history, and political science.

The first class, "The World's Great Religions," to be given on Mondays from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m., will concentrate on giving and understanding of the historical development of various faiths and their contribution to the world cultural heritage.

"Principles of Student Leadership" is the title of a new political science course to be given on Thursdays from 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. Created and designed on the suggestions of the students, it will center on the learning of the elements of group leadership and group dynamics and parliamentary law and procedure.

Those enrolling for the course will also be taught how to conduct meetings and group discussions.

In the field of English, "Report Writing" will be offered for the first time on Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays from 1:30 to 2:30, and "Speed Reading" will be held on Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m.

The former will offer instruction in writing actual reports used in business, industry, and the technical professions, while the latter will concentrate on word-building and vocabulary recognition with special attention placed on words used in the various technology fields.

Registration for the new classes is currently being conducted at the college's Guidance Center, located in the East wing of the Administration Building at 400 West Washington Blvd., from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Further information on the new classes

The new basic physics lab, constructed on the second floor of the Administration Building on the college's Main Campus, will be used for lectures and practical demonstrations by various departments in the school including drafting, metallurgy, and auto mechanics.

Among the \$12,000 worth of equipment house in the lab are charts, an interval contact maker, stroboscopes, a tachometer, wire testing machines, accelerator apparatus, a motor-driven rotator, gyroscopes, a manometer, a hydraulic press, various meters and other equipment.
