blind people.

Communism Film Subject

Two films on communism will be shown Monday, Sept. 18, at 8 p.m. at the Nativity parish auditorium, 1415 Engracia Ave., Torrance.

The films, "Communism On The Map," a vivid description of the rapid spread of communism in the world today, and "Accent On Youth" which explains the attack upon our children, have received much notice.

There will also be a talk about how we can become better informed with the devious workings of the Communist mind. The program is sponsored by the St. Gerard Torrance, Knights of Columbus.

Registration and classes start Sept. 25 and are expected to bring out the largest number of blind students in the organization's history. An expanded educational program will include, for the first time, home economics classes in fully furnished "practice apartments" in which blind people learn the techniques of cooking and housekeeping. Other courses will include classes in arithmetic, grammar, Braille reading and writing, travel training, radio electronics, typing, and home repairs.

The Recreation and Group Work Department will offer some 40 activities or classes including millinery, ceramics, lampshade making, leather work, music, drama, Great Books series, and dress pattern making. Special activities will include dancing lessons, square dancing, outings, and a senior citizens' club. The youth program will feature Saturday morning recreational programs in lo-

cal communities and a Boy Scout program for Braille Troop 82.

Volunteer drivers to transport blind students to and from classes at the Institute are urgently needed, it was added. Drivers should call Betty Sinclair at NO 3-1111, Ext. 20.
