The 39-year-old coach, stricken by a brain hemorrhage while flying with his team for Saturday night's football game in Boise, Ida., was rushed to the Nevada hospital following an emergency landing in Reno.

In a telephone conversation with President Stuart E. Marsee this morning, Mrs. Verry, who flew to her husband's beside Saturday evening, expressed complete confidence in treatment which he is receiving in the Nevada city.




