A small news story that appeared recently in the Torrance Press indicated that the coffers of the city of Torrance had been bolstered with the quarterly allocations of sales and use tax money from the State Board of Equalization.

Specifically, the amount received was \$352,723, which reflected a 3.1 percent hike over the same quarter of the preceeding year.




