Employment Unit Designs Symbol For Local Offices

A new metal sign bearing a symbol indentifying the local employment service with more than 1,800 other offices as part of a nationwide pubemployment service was installed at the Torrance public employment office Sept. Murray Love, local manager, California State Employment Service announced.

he Torrance employment office is one of 100 local offices of the California State Employment Service.

The symbol features silouentering a doorway of a local office. It bears the legend Public Employment Service" at the top and the words "Service for Everyone - Local-State-National" at the bottom.

Love' interpreted the symbol as signifying the door of opportunity - a door open to people seeking suitable job opportunities and to all employers seeking qualified workers.

"A major purpose of the new symbol is to build up goodwill for the public employment service," Love said. "We hope the new symbol will become associated in the public mind with good and useful services.'

The public employment service was created by the Wagner-Peyser Act of 1933. This act directed the U.S.

Labor Department to create the United States Employment Service and to establish and maintain a nationwide system of State-administered State and territorial employment services which would provide placement and other services to workers, employers, and the public.

System includes employment services in the fifty States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and Guam.
