99,999 and You Have Electric Service Meters

A milestone in the history of the South Bay's growth and progress was reached this week with the setting of Southern California Edison Company's 100,000th electric service meter in its Redondo Beach district.

According to Edison District Manager G. L. Blanchard, this indicates that more than 300,000 persons are now living in this district which includes Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach, Torrance, Gardena, Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills, and the county area of the Palos Verdes Peninsula.

Site of the historic meter setting was the new home of Albert McBride, owner of Manhattan Realty Company in Hollywood Riviera. His

all-electric home is in the Peninsula's Miraleste section and was built by Gilbert D. Sellan.

"It is fitting that the new home bearing this symbol of the South Bay's progress has been awarded a Gold Medal in recognition of its ultra-modern electrical excellence," Blanchard said.

He pointed out that the 100,000th meter also is indicative of the South Bay's increasingly important role in Southern California.

"Edison has recorded a 141.7 per cent growth in the population of this Redondo district since 1950. Of the electric company's 29 districts since 1950. Of the electric company's 29 districts in Southern and Central California, the local district has steadily risen in proportion-

ate ranking during the past decade.

"For instance," Blanchard said, "the Redondo district was ranked twelfth in population in 1950. By 1960, it had reached fifth in the Edison system."

The electric company's annual payroll here has increased from slightly less than \$1 million in 1950 to more than \$24 million in 1960, while the number of employees in the district has risen from 235 to 319.

Begonias Need Autumn Care

Most Tuberous Begonias will run out of blooms sometime this month, and there's nothing the gardener can do to prolong the color when it starts to go. Continue watering the plants after bloom is gone, withholding moisture gradually as the plants yellow off.

The stems should be separated from the tubers only when they come off naturally, and this will probably be sometime in November. Dry the tubers, when you do separate them and store them in a cool place until next year.

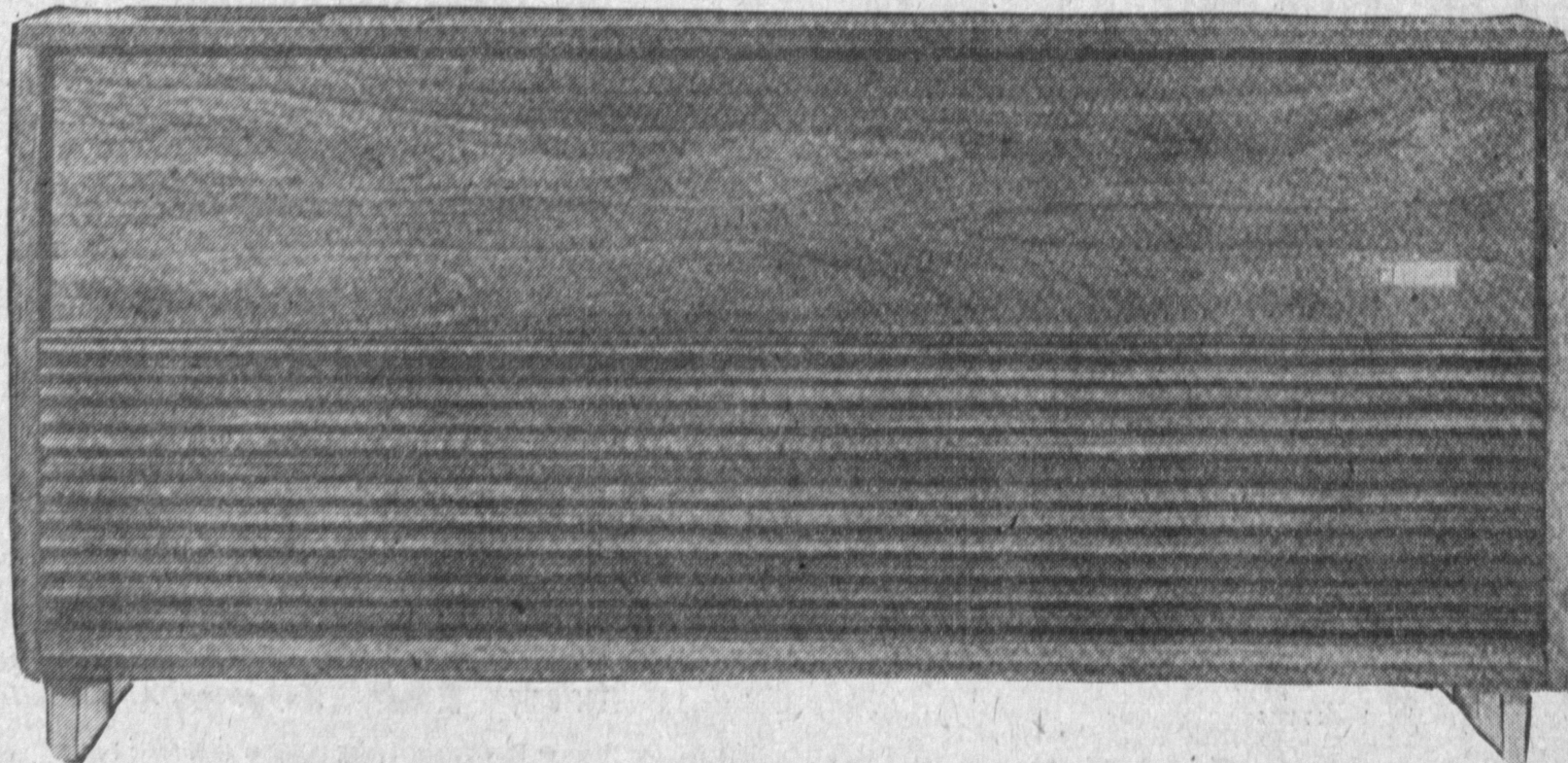
