Edison Puts On Anti-Smog Equipment

Southern California Edison Company this week became the first industrial firm to proceed with installation of anti-smog devices on its fleet of cars and trucks, in response to an appeal by S. Smith Griswold, Los Angeles County Air Pollution Control Officer on behalf of the County Board of Supervisors.

G. L. Blanchard, Edison district manager, announced that the utility would begin immediately to install the device recommended by the County Board of Supervisors to control crankcase emissions on the first 100 of its 2,600 cars and trucks.

"We have been running our own tests on the device insofar as maintenance is concerned," Blanchard stated, "and we have found its performance entirely satisfactory."

Supervisor Warren M. Dorn, chairman of the Air Pollution Control Committee of the Board, commended Edison for voluntarily installing the crankcase control system recommended by the Board of Supervisors. Dorn expressed the hope that other large fleet operators will follow Edison's example.

Before placing its stamp of approval on the "blowby" control, the APCD installed them on 94 cars and drove them a total of more than one and a half million miles, Griswold reported.

CARS EQUIPPED New cars offered for sale throughout California already are being equipped with anti-smog devices, Griswold stated.

"The blowby device is not the complete answer to automobile smog — since we still have to lick the problem of exhaust emissions — but control of crankcase fumes is certainly an important step in the right direction," Griswold declared.

Blowby emissions are, for the most part, hydrocarbons from unburned gasoline which blow by the piston rings and are vented into the atmosphere.

It is estimated that 150 to 180 tons of smog-forming hydrocarbons escape into the air in Los Angeles county each day from this source, Griswold stated.

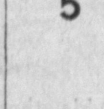
