## Record High Payments at Glendale

Glendale Federal Savings and Loan Association has just completed the finest three-month business period in its history, according to Charles Wellman, president, who announced new record highs in dividend payments to account holders, savings, assets and mortgage loans.

Glendale Federal is paying out a dividend high of \$3,398,000 to its savings customers, Wellman said. During the past quarter, the association attracted net savings (gross savings minus withdrawals) of \$19 million, 21 per cent ahead of the previous high of \$15.7 million established during the first quarter of 1961, and 110 per cent better than third quarter-1960 results.

The hike in savings dollars boosted Glendale Federal's savings deposits over the \$300 million mark. Total savings now stand at \$319 million, 18 per cent ahead of the corresponding period of 1960.

The unit is presently equipped to handle four patients with plans for expansion ready, should additional need develop.

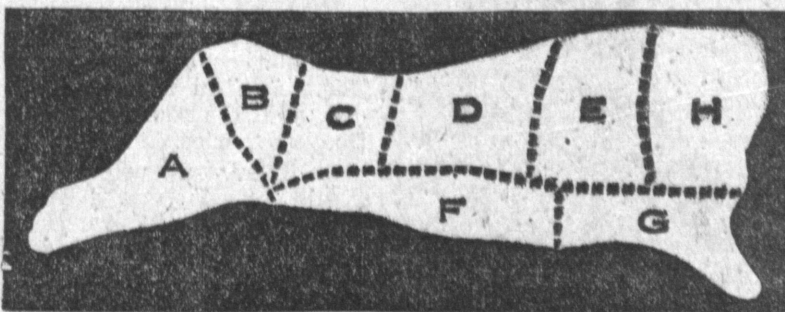

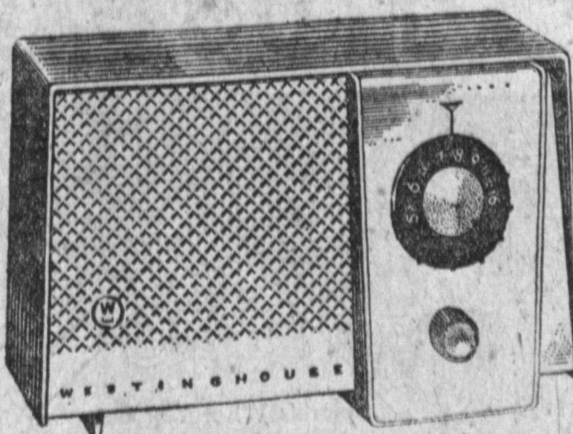
