Long Beach's Chris Dawson fired four, El Camino's John Torok and East Los Angeles' Frank Alderette each launched three and Santa Monica's Rand Carter connected twice.

AERIAL ATTACK

The rash of aerial strikes mirrored the exciting action before an overflow crowd at El Camino where Long Beach had to fight for its life to stave off the Warriors' bid, 29-22. El Camino led until late in the second quarter and was on the Vikings' 2-yard line when the final gun went off.

Meanwhile, in a free-scoring melee, Santa Monica subdued East*Los Angeles 37-20; Bakersfield blanked Harbor College, 42-0; and Valley College scored its first touchdown of the year but was defeated by San Diego, 26-6.

All the touchdowns in the El Camino-Long Beach fray were on passes.

El Camino's Torok cut loose to end Mike Andrews for a pair (37 and 11 yards) and also hit Howard Taylor with a 5-yarder.
