member pledge signing campaign Saturday. David de Waal, temperance director of the church, said the local congregation is joining some 13,000 other Adventist church congregations of more than 1,000,000 members around the world

in the signature campaign. Purpose of the campaign, according to de Waal, is to dramatize Adventists' belief that alchohol and tobacco are harmful to the body which the Bible calls "the temple of the Holy Spirit."
