Reservations for Thanksgiving are now being taken by the Polynesian.

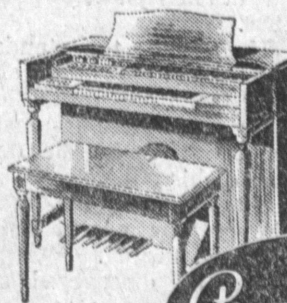
