

Torrance Volunteers Cop Prizes at Harbor Area Chest Report Meeting

A record crowd of 500 Community Chest volunteers from all Harbor area cities attended the area report and luncheon meeting last week at the Ports O' Call Restaurant in San Pedro.

Restaurant's banquet room was filled to capacity as workers gathered to hear results and the progress of the campaign to date.

First report meeting for the area showed that Harbor City-Lomita leads all other cities and has pushed

its campaign over more than 100 per cent of its quota—the first city to do so in the current Los Angeles Chest campaign.

Vince Bauchiero, city chairman for Harbor City-Lomita, reported \$2,669—136.67 per cent—had been raised. Goal set for the area was \$1,953.

Torrance Chest leaders reported 59.84 per cent of their goal had been raised. However, at this stage of the campaign figures fluctuate as reports are still being tabulated as the campaign continues.
