## National Phone Books at Torrance Branch Library

A "conversation piece" has been added to the County Library's book collection in this region that could start tongues wagging from coast-to-coast.  
It's a set of the telephone directories of most of the major cities in the country. Now if one wants to know if John Doe or Richard Roe still live in New York, and if so, where, all they have to do is visit the regional headquarters branch, the Torrance branch, at 1345 Post Avenue, and check on the directories for Manhattan, Brooklyn and the Bronx.

Regional librarian, Betty Lee Addison, who announced the new service, said those who desire information from the big books may come to the library and do their own checking, or if preferred, may telephone.

**241 COMMUNITIES**  
The collection represents 241 communities, including all of the state capitals, the 70 cities that were the largest when the last census was taken, most of the cities and towns in California, and even London, England.  
In addition to the regular directories the classified directories of the 11 largest U.S. cities are included.  
A standing order has been placed with the telephone companies for new editions as soon as they are released. When a new edition arrives, the old one is placed in the Manhattan Beach branch, 425 15th Street, Manhattan Beach.

Miss Addison said the collection is used heavily by business and industry to locate manufacturers, dealers and distributors in other cities, and by professional firms, as well as private individuals.
