PREVAILING WAGE SCALE: Pursuant to the provisions of the Labor Code of the State of Ca the County Board of Supervisors has ascertained the prevailing rate diem wages in dollars, based on a working day of eight hours, feraft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the propos tract, and will require that not less than said rates be paid to all such men or mechanics employed or engaged on the work. The Contractor shall, as a penalty to the State or political suben whose behalf the contract is made or awarded, forfeit ten doll each calendar day, or portion thereof, for each workman paid less the stipulated prevailing rates for any public work done under the conhim or by any subcontractor under him, and the body awarding the shall cause to be inserted in the contract a stipulation to this effect. Provided that overtime rates, rates of pay for Saturdays, Sunday shall apply to those holidays as recognized in the collective him agreement applicable to the particular craft, classification or workman employed on the project.
