"A special federal grand fury should be covened to study this problem and to initiate action against the automobile industry," Hahn declared.

FEDERAL ACTION He added that action in the federal courts would be required tot compel the automotive industry to meet its responsibility for the health and welfare of the 6,000,000 people of Los Angeles County since the federal government is the onl yagency that can require the automobile makers to perfect and install smog eliminating exhaust devices on new cars as they off the assembly line.


