License Deadline Near, Says DMV

Torrance Director Warns Drivers to 'Get 'Em in Early'

warned this week not to wait until the last minute to apply for their 1962 license tabs.

Leonard D. Townsend, manager of the Torrance branch of the Department of Motor Vehicles, said that during the last week of registration the applicant may have to wait for two or three hours to process his license. If he applies now he can be in and out in a matter of minutes, Townsend said.

Half the period granted by State law for annual renewal of motor vehicle registration has now passed.

JANUARY 'SPURT' "A spurt of public re-

sponse to the registration fee statements at the start of January, followed by a drop in applications at DMV windows, is developing as the pattern again this year, Townsend said.

"Some owners seem to be postponing their registrations although a large influx of mail-in registrations has been noted."

This is the first year that applicants have been allowed to mail in requests for registration to local

Townsend stressed that renewal in person at a DMV field office, a temporary bank station or, for members of auto clubs, at these organizations' offices is the most efficient method of obtaining 1962 vehicle registration. On payment of fees the applicant immediately receives his rear-plate renewal sticker. Any correction of address or other data about car ownership can be done on the spot.

Deadline for getting the new tabs is Feb. 5, Townsend concluded. Fee penalties must be paid after the deadline.
