

Seahawks Go Up Against Vaunted Bakersfield Friday

Harbor College's Seahawks, sitting in third position in the Metropolitan Conference after victories over Long Beach City College and San Diego, will attempt to improve their standing this week when they go against Bakersfield. Friday night the Seahawks travel to Bakersfield to meet the Renegades on their home court.

At the present time Harbor's 2-1 record puts them in third place behind El Camino and Valley, both undefeated after three games. Bakersfield has won one and lost two while Santa Monica, working on a losing streak extending through last season, has not won a game in three league attempts.

Against Long Beach the Hawks had a bad first half as they could get only 17 points to 21 for the Vikings. In the second half though, the Hawks came to life with Charles Campbell leading the way. Campbell, who scored with every shot in the book, and some that were not, ended up with 27 points, 23 of them in the second half. Final score Harbor 64, Long Beach 50.

SCORERS

Following Campbell in the scoring column were Al Windfeldt with 11 points and Ronald Stark with 10. Leading scorers for Long Beach were Lawes, 13, Erickson and Dick, 11.

The Knights of San Diego came to town with one thing in mind—revenge. The Hawks had defeated the Knights in the Sam Barry tournament to win the Consolation Crown and San Diego was out to avenge the loss.

The game started off with both teams hitting well and at the half the Hawks were in command 31-23. In the second half Harbor started to pull away, leading at one time by 14 points. But San Diego, behind the fine performances of Nathan Mathis and Al Catlin, came roaring back to trail by only one point in the final seconds of the game. They could not outshoot the clock and fell one short 64-65.

For the Hawks, Ed Briscoe was top man with 20 points followed by Windfeldt 17, Alan Ryan 11, and Campbell 10. For the losers Catlin had 19 and Mathis 14.

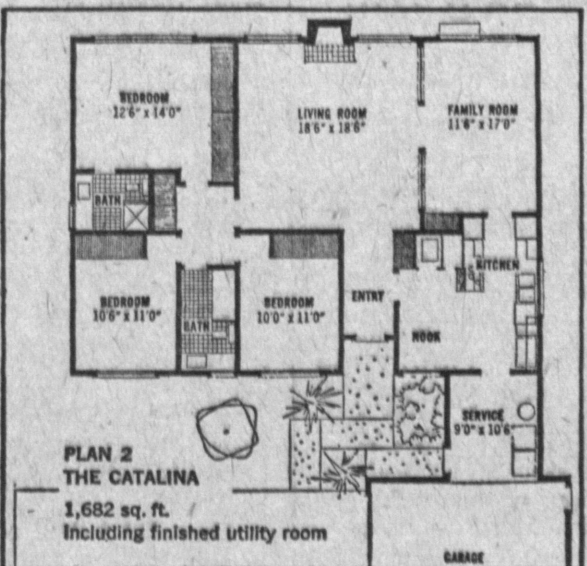

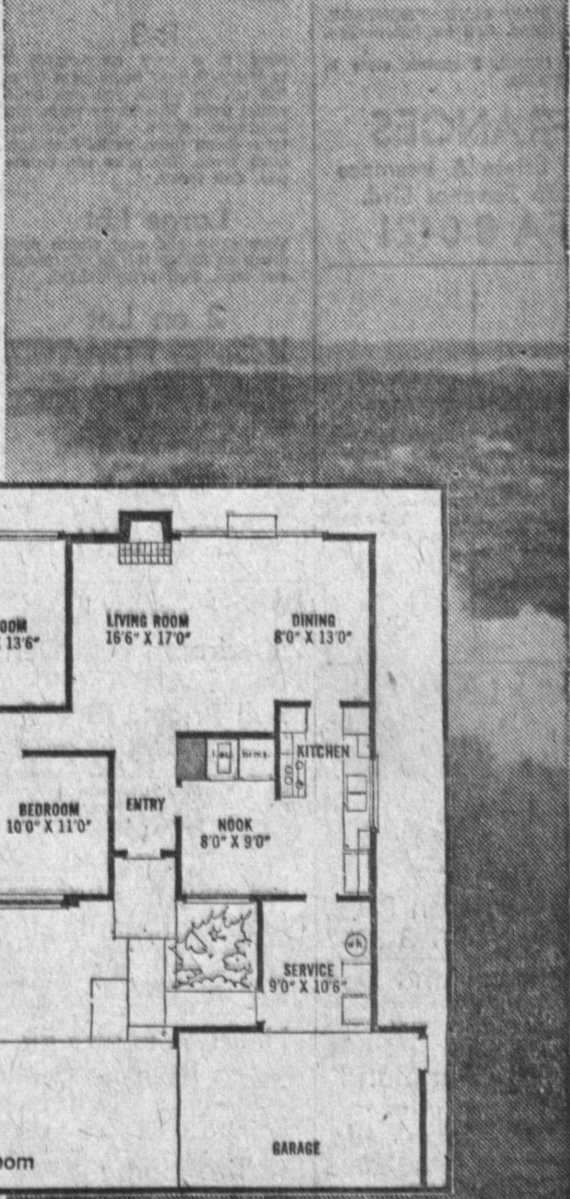
