Men between the ages of 17 and 35 can be immediately enlisted. The short-term active duty training program had been suspended to avoid clogging training camps during the buildup of the active Army for the Berlin crisis.

Since Sept. 1, enlistments in the six-month training program had been limited to youths between 17 and 20. However, the program has now returned to what was mormal prior to the buildup with men accepted between the ages of 17 and 35 years.

OBLIGATION A man enlisting between the ages of 17 and 181/2 years incurs an eight year obligation, which may be fulfilled by six months active duty training, three years in the Ready Reserve and four and


