b) Intermediate—handicap and scratch, individual average minimum 111 to maximum 125, team average minimum 350 to 375, 10 a.m., April 25.

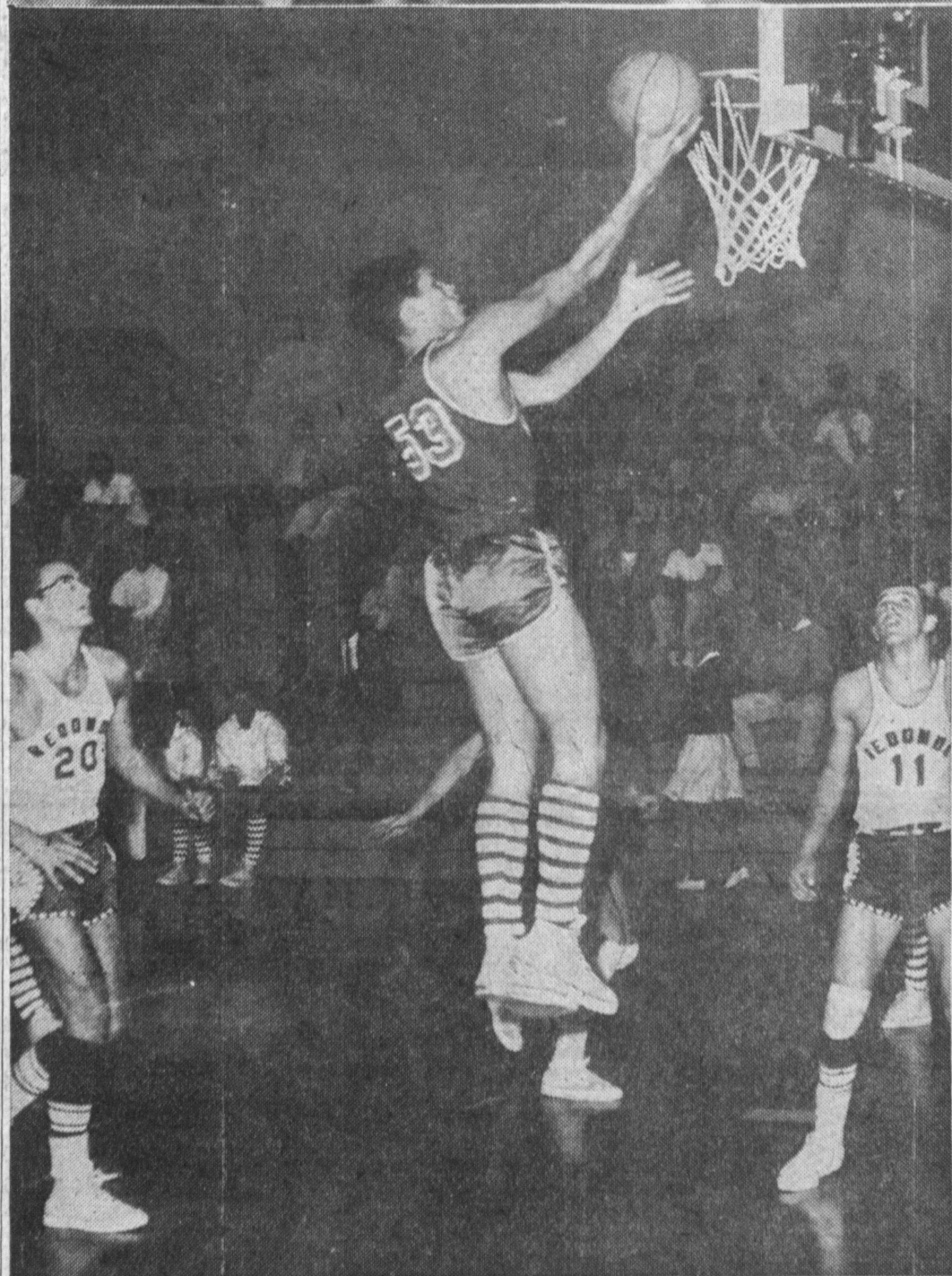
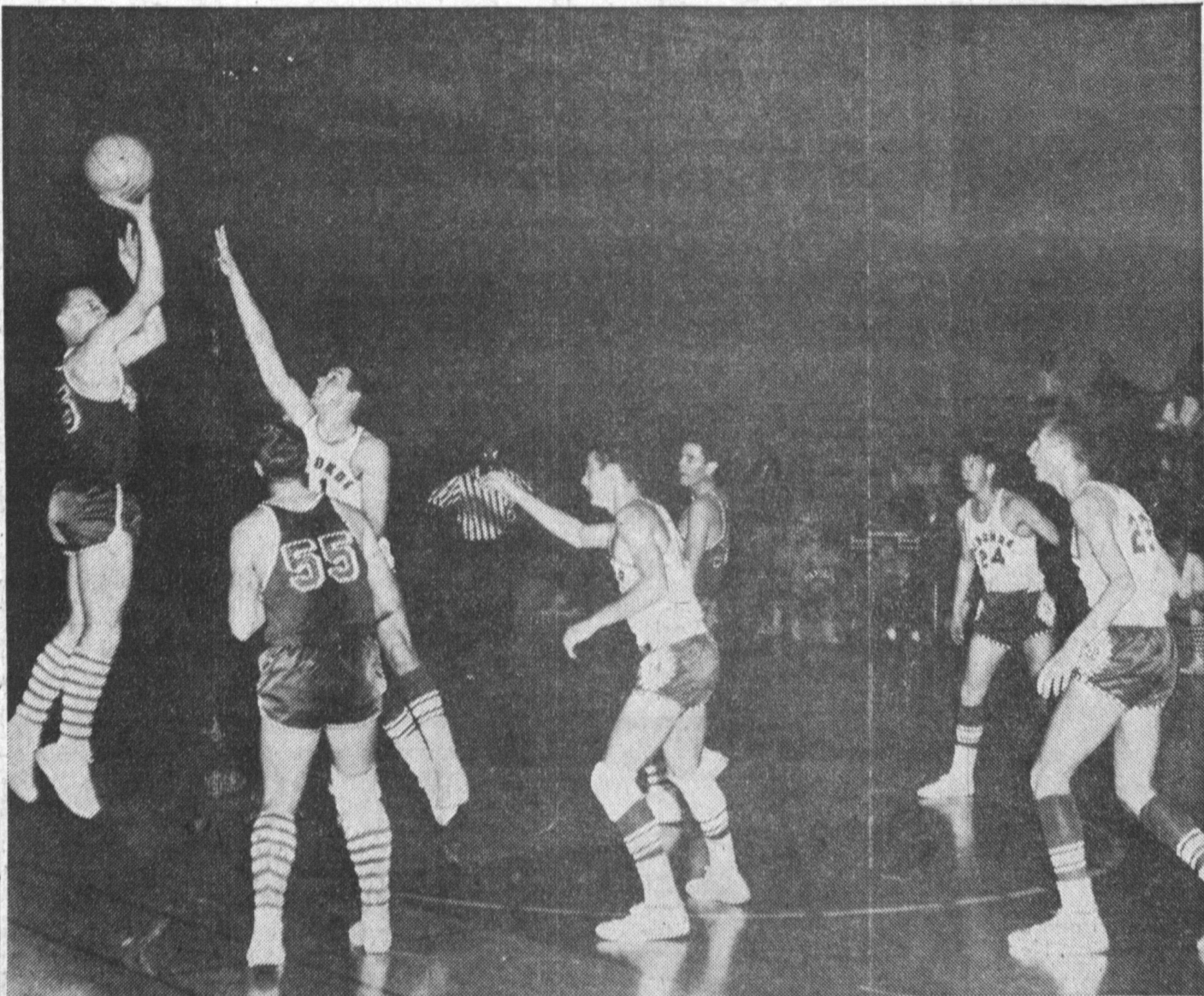
c) Advance—handicap and scratch, individual average min. 126 to max. 150, team average min. 376 to max. 450, 10 a.m., April 26.
