

## Savings Bond Chairman Announces Area's Goal

Torrance Community Savings Bonds Chairman George W. Post recently disclosed this area bought \$242,057.57 in U.S. Savings Bonds in January towards its assigned goal to find purchase of national defense items to strengthen the country against Communist aggression.

Sales of E and H Bonds were 7.6 per cent higher in this county for this January as compared to the same month of last year. For Southern California they were \$19,230,197, up 10.5 per cent over a year ago.

### GOAL

Chairman Post, announcing the figures, said:

"This area has a goal of \$1,231,330 to sell in United States Savings Bonds from the first of the year through next June to make its patriotic effort to help in the funding of the vastly expensive weapons, planes, ships, missiles and equipment of the Space Age.

"In this way everyone can participate in the defense of the survival of this free nation. Some can wear the soldier's uniform of freedom and man our national defense equipment; some can go overseas on peace missions; some can use great talents in scientific experiments to probe space; a few brave men will ride space vehicles towards the moon; but everyone can help protect priceless liberties by

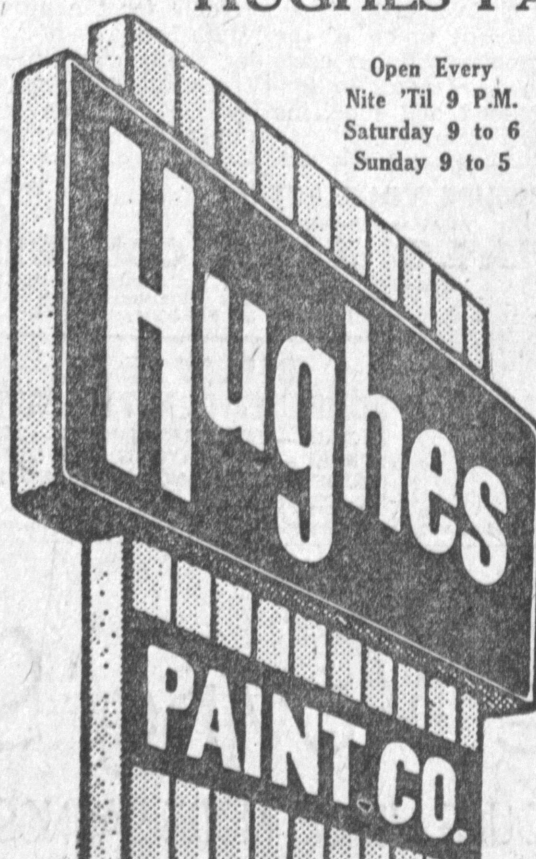
