

Robert F. Williams Will Conduct Southwest Youth Symphony Concert

Mr. Robert F. Williams, in the music department at Bancroft Junior High and a resident of Torrance, will conduct the Southwest Youth Symphony spring concert, April 8, 7:30 p.m., at Sportsman's County Park, 98th and Western.

Williams has been conducting and managing rehearsals of the orchestra for the past three years and the group presents five or more concerts annually, free to the public.

He graduated from Pepperdine College where he conducted the symphonic choir. At the University of Southern California, Williams finished post graduate work. Presently, he plays woodwind and is a member of the Los Angeles Symphonic Band.

Assistant conductor with the Southwest Youth Symphony is Gerald H. Winter, from the music department

at Henry Clay Junior High. The concert of April 8 includes a chorus from Morningside High School, under the direction of Mr. Don G. Fontana.
