

'An Evening With Odetta' to Be Presented in HS Auditorium

Jerry Goldbach, formerly of the nationally known Gateway Singers, is bringing "An Evening With Odetta" to Redondo Union High School on March 23. The Concert will begin at 8:30 p.m. This is Goldbach's first attempt to bring prestige concerts and artists to the South Bay area. Another concert of high cultural interest is scheduled for May.

Odetta is one of America's finest folk singing artists. She is a tall, handsome woman, born in Birmingham, Alabama, who grew up in Los Angeles, and discovered folk music after much classical coaching while she was in San Francisco with the West Coast cast of "Finian's Rainbow."

She has since confined her realm to the folk art because she finds in it musical freedom and lyrics that express her own sympathies and yearnings. Her repertoire spans virile work songs, hand-clapping chants, spirituals and lullabies. She has had outstanding en-

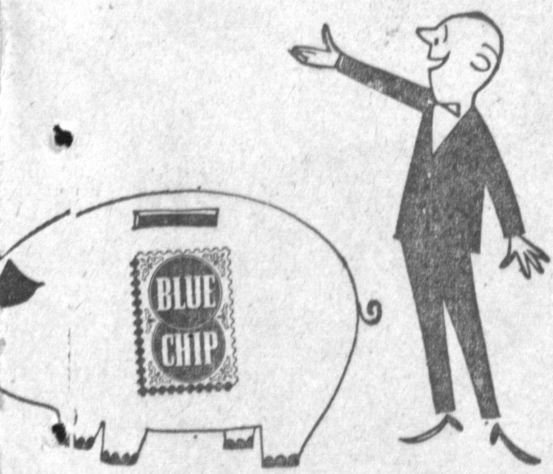

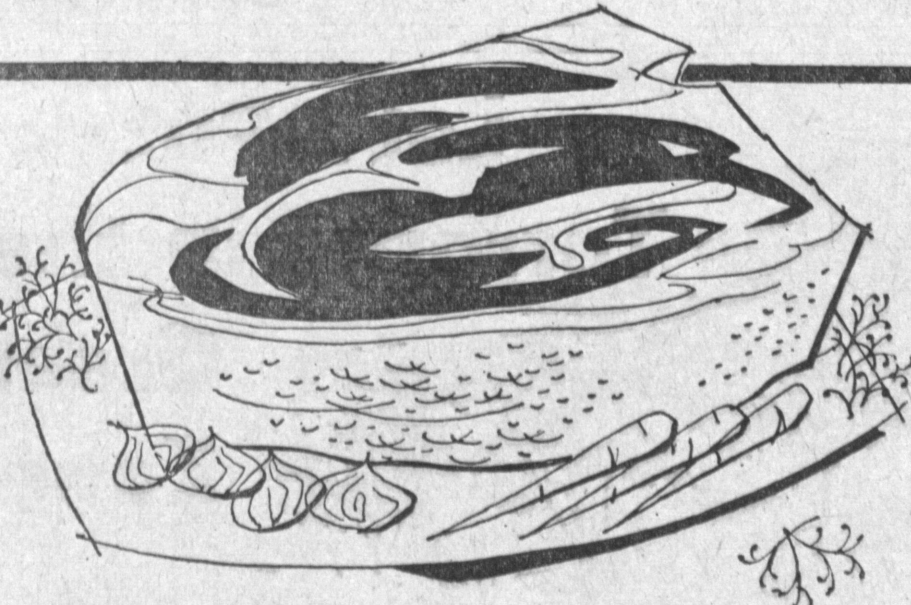
