## Torrance Firm Gets NASA Moon Rocket Subcontract

In what is a major development in the U.S. race to the moon, the Tylan Corporation of Torrance, has been selected by the National Aeronautics and Space Administration to develop a ground check-out power supply system for the Saturn moon rocket. The ten-story Saturn booster vehicle, now under construction at the Marshall Space Flight Center in Huntsville, Alabama, weighs over a million pounds. It is scheduled to be operational in 1964 for sending the three-man Apollo spacecraft to the moon and to boost a space station into orbit around the earth.

According to Tylan officials Charles Drexel and Dan LeMay, the Tylan power supply furnishes precise direct current to check out portions of the electrical equipment in the booster. Performance, size and reliability were key factors influencing the selection.

## New Engineering Head at Torrance Steel Plant

W. Kenneth Scott has been appointed superintendent of engineering and maintenance of the Torrance Works of U. S. Steel's Columbia-Geneva Division. It was announced today by E. C. Kinyon, general superintendent.

Scott was transferred from the division's San Francisco headquarters where he had been assistant chief engineer-design and consulting since 1959. He succeeds Ray W. Pett, Torrance Works superintendent of engineering and maintenance since 1959.

In one of three lateral transfers simultaneously announced by Kinyon, Pett was named superintendent of rolling mill. He succeeds William M. Montgomery who moves to superintendent of open hearth, replacing Robert J. Prout.

Prout has been appointed assistant to the general superintendent, a new position at the Torrance Works.

Scott brings to the Torrance Works 40 years' experience in the steel industry. He began his career with the Otis Steel Company plate mill, Cleveland, Ohio. Two years later he joined the former Columbia Steel Company as a crane operator in the Pittsburgh Works.

By 1939 he was electrical supervisor on major development projects at Pittsburgh, and shortly thereafter became maintenance superintendent of the Pittsburgh Defense Foundry.
