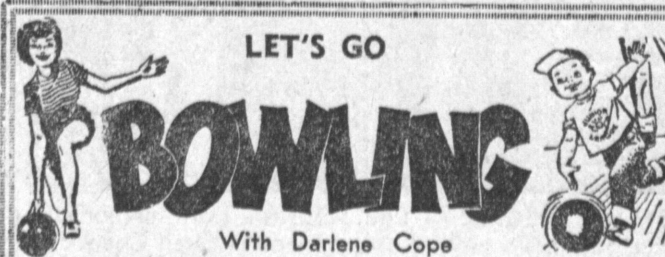

## All-Metropolitan Conference Guard Dan Karavas of El Camino Listed As 'Top Man' for Cager Season

All-Metropolitan Conference guard Dan Karavas wound up as top man for the El Camino College cagers in points per game and assists, statistics released today by Warrior coach George Stanich reveal.

Karavas, named to the all-star squad by the Metro coaches, averaged 14.4 points per game to lead the Tribe and also assisted in 47 goals to top that division with ease.

Following Karavas in assists was center Keith Erickson with 30. Erickson led the squad in rebounds with 235, followed by Ron Dinnel (200) and Mike Schrader (125).

Dinnel was top man for the Indians in the field goal shooting percentage department, hitting at a 49.6 rate. Erickson was runner-up

with 43.6 per cent followed by Gary Nixt, 38.1.

Schrader averaged 75.3 per cent from the free throw line to head the Tribe as Dave Brown hit at a 69.6 clip and Paul Ingelman dropped in 68.2 per cent of his charity tosses.

Following Karavas in the points-per-game department were Dinnel (13.1), Erickson (12.2), Schrader (10.2), Ingelman (7.2), Brown (5.6), Nixt (3.6), Ron Lewis (3.0), Paul Bush (2.5) and Vern Holte (2.4).

Under the tutoring of Coach Stanich, the predominantly freshman EC five broke even for the season, finishing with a 14-14 record. The Indians tied for third in the Metro Conference with San Diego by accumulating an 8-6 mark.

## Tumbling Honor Roll Finds Ten Boys Qualified

This year for the first time at Stephen M. White High School a Tumbling Honor Roll has been established to honor those boys who accomplish ten of the most difficult tumbling stunts for junior high school students.
