AS I PLAY

THE MAGIC NUMBER

Partnership in bridge is one of the most important aspects of the game. You have to learn to trust your partner. He is usually the only one at the table you can believe. Remember, your opponents are trying to confuse you or take up your bidding room with their overcalls.

Opening the bidding at the level of one is seldom done in either the first, second, or fourth seats with less than the Magic Number. Third seat, maybe less if there is a long suit and you can take the first or second trick in that suit.

SHOWS PARTNER

The magic number is much more than just 13 points in high cards and distribution. It shows partner that the hand contains it's share of the high cards, (10 points), that the hand contains two fast taking tricks if the opponents buy the contract, that the suit bid is a biddable suit (four cards with four high card points), and most important it shows partner that the opener is prepared to bid again regardless of the responder's call. My opening bids are always preparedness bids. I am prepared to bid again and have thought ahead before I make the initial call, so that no bid by my partner will embarrass me at a rebid.

When I open the bidding with a hand that contains less than the magic number, usually it is with the preparedness bid of one club. This permits partner, to bid any suit at the one level, and allows me to rebid one no trump, saying that I opened a "Minie," and will pass any bid he makes unless he takes drastic action.

Job's Daughters Hold Fashion Show at Congregational Church

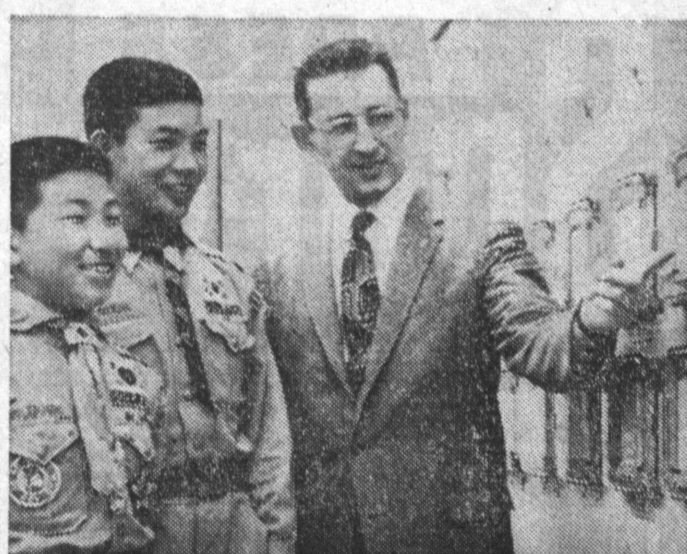
Bethel 36 of the International Order of Job's Daughters held a pot-luck dinner and fashion show last month.
